The League of Women Voters was founded in 1920, just prior to the ratification of the 19th amendment to the U.S. Constitution that gave women the right to vote. Now, as then, its purpose is to provide materials to enable voters to become informed before casting their ballots.

The League of Women Voters is a nonpartisan political membership organization, neither supporting nor opposing political parties or candidates for public office. The League encourages informed and active participation of citizens in government, works to increase understanding of major public policy issues, and influences public policy through education and advocacy.

In addition to this brochure, the League of Women Voters of the Fairfax Area (LWVFA) provides publications and sponsors forums and other opportunities to learn about candidates and election issues. The LWVFA publishes a *Voters' Guide* prior to each general election which lists all qualified candidates, bond issues and referenda on the ballot; it also includes candidates' responses to questions posed by the LWVFA. The *Voters' Guide* may be found in local newspapers and on our website.

The LWVFA is financed through the dues and donations of its members and contributions from interested citizens and businesses. Membership is open to men and women who are at least 18 years of age. New members are always welcome.

Election Calendar 2012

Voter registration is closed for the 21 days before a regularly scheduled election, 6 days before a special elections for statewide offices and 13 days for others. Special elections are called to fill vacancies.

VOTING INFORMATION

POLLS ARE OPEN FROM 6 A.M. TO 7 P.M. FOR ALL ELECTIONS

Check your current Voter Information Card for your correct voting site (due to redistricting there may be changes). Voting information is available in Spanish at the Fairfax Board of Elections Office. **Election officers at all polling places are required to request identification from each voter. If you are unable to provide acceptable identification, you may complete, under oath, an Affirmation of Identity.** Contact your General Registrar for appropriate forms of identification. **All polling sites offer "curbside voting" for voters at least 65 years of age or with a physical disability.**

Voter Registration

You are eligible to register to vote if you are:

- A citizen of the United States;
- A resident of Virginia;
- At least 18 years of age on or before the date of the next general election; and
- Have not had your voting rights removed by a court.

WHERE: Voter Registration Applications in PDF format are available online at www.sbe.virginia.gov. Applications are also available at most public libraries and state and local government offices.

WHEN: Voter Registration Applications are accepted year round. Books close for the 21 days before a general or primary election. Applications arriving during that time will be processed *after* that election. Contact your General Registrar for additional information. Registration is permanent in most circumstances.

UPDATE: To remain a qualified voter in all elections, you must notify your General Registrar of any change in name or address in a timely manner.

Absentee Voting

Any voter who meets eligibility requirements may vote by absentee ballot. Visit www.sbe.virginia.gov for a list of the requirements. There are special provisions for military and overseas voters and emergencies.

BY MAIL: The application for an absentee ballot to be sent by mail can be downloaded from www.sbe.virginia.gov. You may also request an application by contacting your Office of Elections. Applications may be submitted up to twelve months prior to an election, but must be received no later than 5 p.m. on the seventh day prior to an election. **Voted ballots must be received in the Office of Election by 7 p.m. on Election Day. They are not accepted at polling locations.**

IN PERSON: Registered voters may apply for, and vote, an absentee ballot in person in the Office of Elections or at designated satellite locations beginning 45 days before general and primary elections. In-person absentee voting is available in all localities through the Saturday before each Election Day.
